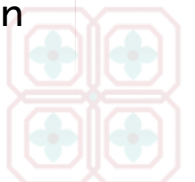

The Economic Reform Team (ERT) is a voluntary initiative from prominent Yemeni businessmen, businesswomen, and economic experts. The ERT aims to enable the private sector to uniformly and effectively contribute to decision-making and to develop visions, strategies, and policies that promote economic reforms and growth in Yemen. The ERT strives to include wide-ranging viewpoints informed by private sector stakeholders across the country.

The Team was established in 2012 following the Center for International Private Enterprise (CIPE) organized "Strengthening the Voice of the Private Sector" workshop at the Dead Sea in Amman. Key stakeholders for this meeting included the Studies & Economic Media Center (SEMC), the Yemeni Business Club (YBC), and the main chambers of commerce in Sana 'a, Aden, Hudaydah, Taiz, and Hadramawt.

ERT's Objectives:

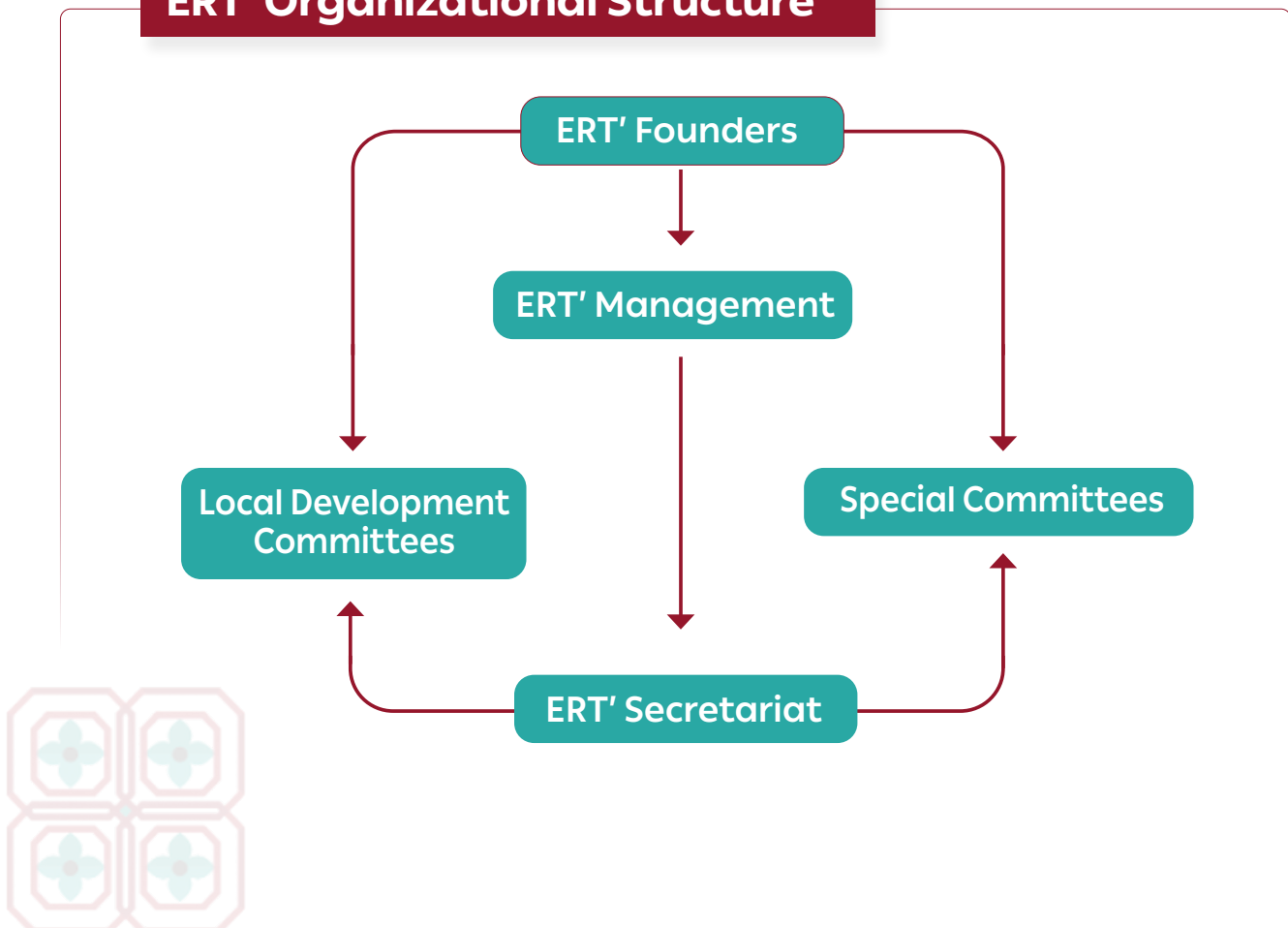
- Enhance private sector participation in economic policymaking by through targeted outreach, capacity-building programs, and other activities.
